## Winter Scavenger Hunt

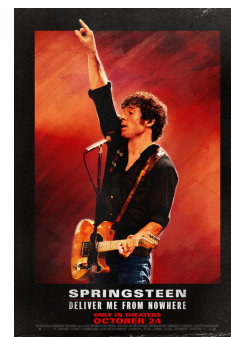

Come and learn the art of origami folding and create a brilliantly colored radial design. Young artists will create two artworks, one to hang in the library during Youth Art Month and one to take home.

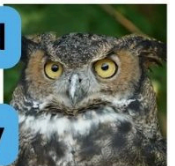


## Tween Scene: Mission to the Moon
